Learn about effective classroom practices that positively impact emergent literacy development and are most appropriate for early learning settings. Topics covered will be:

- Oral Language Development (phonemic awareness, vocabulary development/expansion and oral comprehension).
- Interactive Read Alouds/Shared Reading (making meaning, receptive and expressive language, early print concepts and word recognition).
- Shared/Interactive Writing (phonological awareness and phonics, oral expression along with letter recognition and letter formation, and sentence expansion).

Expand understanding of how these classroom instructional practices help young learners develop literacy skills and prepare them for future literacy instruction in Kindergarten and beyond.
